* At this time, we will be utilizing the Eli Mack Room of the Lexington Municipal Building. However, we reserve the right to change the location if necessary.

* **Attendance is required on all 6 days for 45 hours credit.**

* Failure to attend the first day, and missing more than one day, will result in an automatic roll over to the following class session. Make up time, if a full day is missed other than day one, will be at the convenience of the educator. There is an additional fee for any make up days.

* The Methods of Teaching course can be taken at any time once you have received your Cosmetology, Esthetics, or Nail Technology license. However, you must be licensed for two years before you can test to receive your Instructor license.

* **COVID attendance measures will be taken as decided by the provider.**

Any late payments must be made with cash.

You must attend all classes and complete all assignments for credit.

Option #1 - Early Bird Special Payment – SAVE \$100

Total cost - \$850 with this special. To qualify - you must pay a total of \$425 by December 9, 2022. \$200 now will hold you a spot in the class but you must also pay the remaining \$225 balance of the first installment by December 9, 2022. The remaining balance of \$425 would be due on or before the first day of class – February 4, 2023. You may make payments along the way towards your balance in amounts of \$100 or more. All payments are through Venmo or Cash App. There will be a 3% convenience fee added each time you submit a payment. If you do not meet the December 9th deadline, you will automatically be rolled over to Option #2.

Option #2 – Regular Plan

Total Cost - \$950. You must pay a total of \$475 by January 6, 2023. \$200 now will hold you a spot in the class but you must also pay the remaining \$275 balance of the first installment by January 6, 2023. The remaining balance of \$475 would be due on or before the first day of class – February 4, 2023. You may make payments along the way towards your balance in amounts of \$100 or more. All payments are through Venmo or Cash App. There will be a 3% convenience fee added each time you submit a payment.

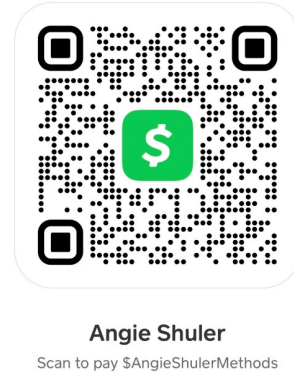

1. Be sure you have **written in the name** on the registration you want to be called. It will be on your name tag.
2. A map to the location may be emailed to you if you requested one. See written directions at the end of this letter. The map is also on our web site at www.kennethshuler.com.
3. You may send a **deposit of \$200.00** to hold your spot, with the remaining due on the dates listed on the registration form, per your option.

Cosmetology – Milady's Standard Cosmetology (2012 or newer). Salon Fundamentals is also acceptable.

Nail Technology - Milady's Standard Nail Technology (2010 or newer)

Esthetics - Milady's Standard Esthetics Fundamentals (2012 or newer)

Barbering - Milady's Standard Professional Barbering (2010 or newer)
